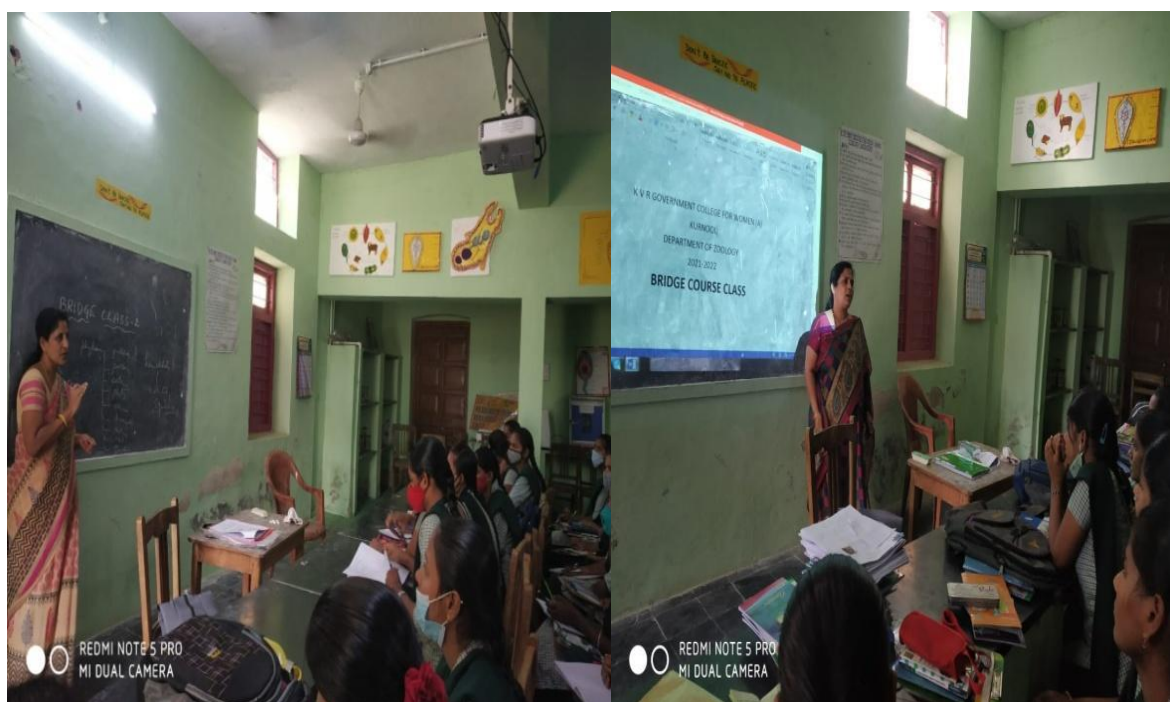
Objective:

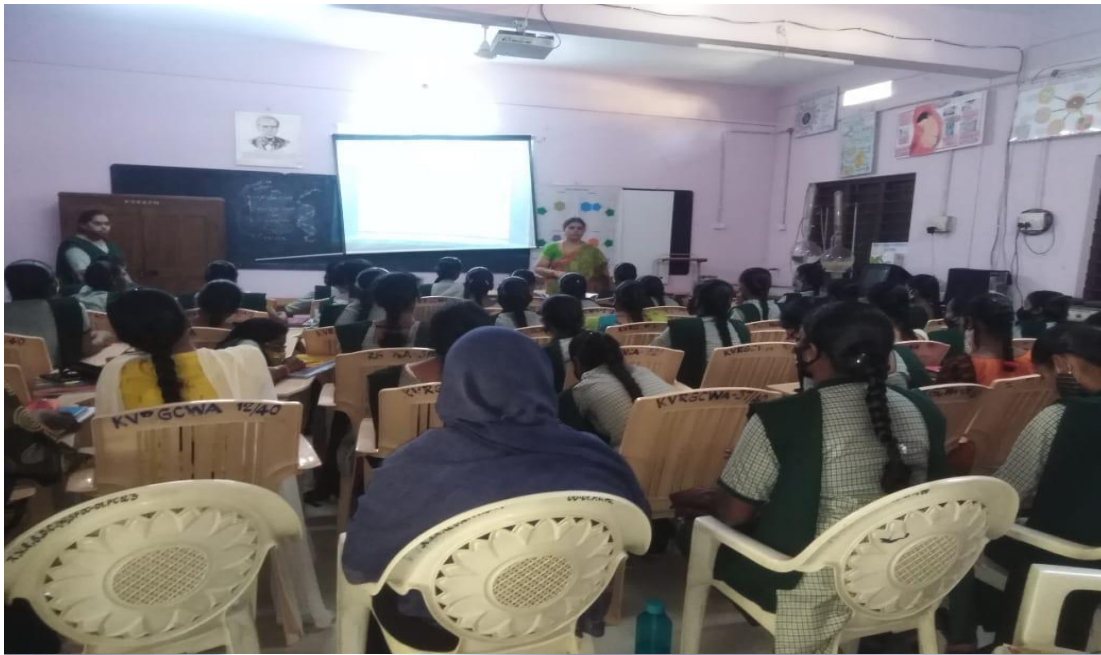
