Students are randomly selected for the survey by system. Except particular student nobody will know which student has received the SSS email and what they have responded. Thus the students will remain anonymous throughout the process.


Student Survey has 30 to 60 weightage (as per type of institution) in the scoring of institutional Grade and hence responses from students can play a critical role in determining institutional grade. Student Satisfaction Survey 2021-22

Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted through a Questionnaire (Google Form) Consisting of twenty-one Questions. Twenty Questions are Objective, in nature, while one question is open ended to elicit observations and suggestions for improvements providing an opportunity to the student to give suggestions and criticism in their own words. For the Twenty objective questions, students responded on a Likert scale of 4 to 0, with the most positive response rated as 4, and most negative response rated as 0. The mean Score for each question will be calculated and the overall mean will be arrived at. This figure will range from 4 to 0 and will give the mean satisfaction level of the students for the institute. This figure in the range of 4 to 0 will be the score indicators 'Student Satisfaction survey'. 325 students of total strength participated in the survey.
