- c. Provide necessary help in Organizing Workshops/conferences and Personality Development Programmes at YVU for enhancement of skills in respect of Faculty, Staff and Students of KVR.
- d. Provide necessary support for establishment of Video satellite link and assistance in development of E-class rooms, Lab, Curriculum, establishment of research Labs, Training & Placement and Library etc. at KVR.

### 3. Proposed Modes of Collaboration

YVU and KVR propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Cooperation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- b) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between YVU and KVR.

### 4. Terms and Conditions

- a) The faculty members and students of KVR can use the library facility of YVU for short-time.
- b) Usage of YVU academic infrastructure can be allowed for limited period subject to its availability, approval of Head of the facility/department and Institute norms.
- c) Both institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- d) This MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the *institutes* at any time.
- e) Either *Institute* shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other *institute*.


### 5. Duration of MOU

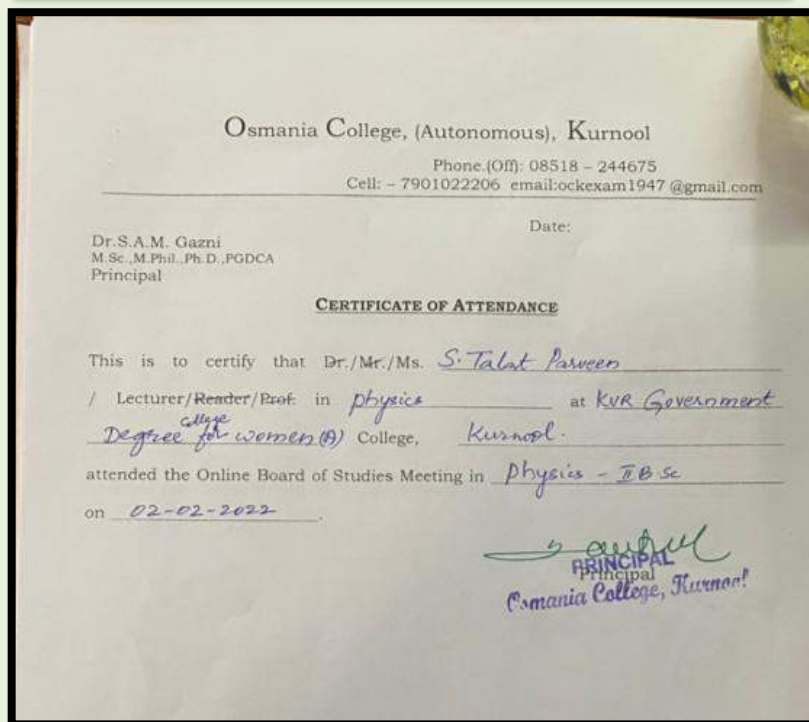
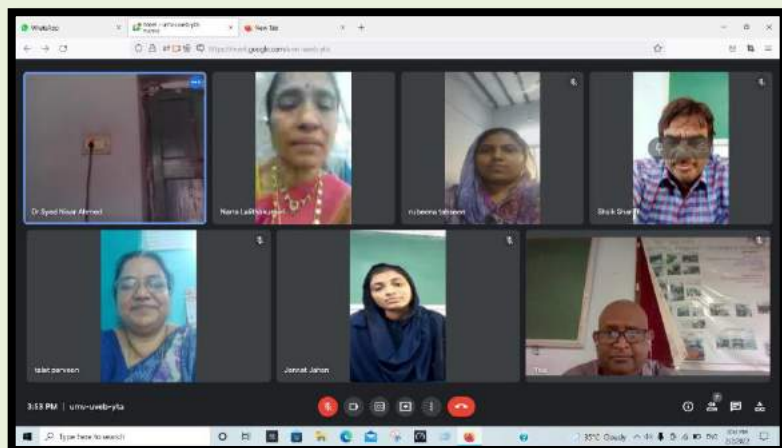



This Agreement shall taken effect when signed by the official representatives of the institutions and will remain in effect for an initial period of Five years and may be extended by mutual agreement in writing for additional five year period. Either party may terminate this Agreement with one year (01 year) 2021-22 written notice of intent to terminate.

Any modification shall require the written approval of the official representatives of each institution or their designees.

*Abstract*

The WHO declared the novel coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) an emergency of international concern on 30 January 2020 and a pandemic on 11 March. According to WHO's Situation Report - 79, as of 13 August 2021, the epidemic has caused 43,23,139 deaths worldwide. While it is seemingly nearing its end in China, where it was first reported, it is still on the rise in Europe, in the USA and in other parts of the world, including in many low-income and middle-income countries (LMICs). The pandemic has triggered unprecedented measures worldwide. Many countries have installed travel bans, confinement and lockdown policies. These responses have been adopted in an 'emergency' mode, and are largely reactionary, aimed at mitigating the spread of the disease while waiting for a specific cure and/or vaccine to be developed. The COVID-19 pandemic has triggered unprecedented measures worldwide, which have often been adopted in an 'emergency' mode and are largely reactionary a paradigm shift in global health governance, from a specific reactional paradigm to a systemic, coordinated and preventive paradigm aimed at helping populations reduce their individual risk factors and augment their natural immunity.

The world is now witnessing a paradigm shift, Nations everywhere are grappling with the concurrent waves of the Covid-19 pandemic. The deterioration in relationship with china with the countries of the world, shifting traditional geo-political issues. In addition to this transitions in old geopolitical issues, there are some ongoing global trends that cannot be ignored. More than 30 years after the Cold War, the Western victors are finding that their firm-held values, such as liberal democracy and free market economies, are clouded with doubts. Digital transformation is another trend that bears scrutiny. As artificial intelligence and the internet of things develop with increasing speed, they will have unprecedented effects on people's lives, national governance and international politics in the upsurge of Global Pandemics like COVID-19. Meanwhile, in Japan's immediate vicinity, massive militaries still confront each other on the Korean Peninsula, Afghanistan, Middle-Eastern countries the possibility of abrupt changes there cannot be ruled out.

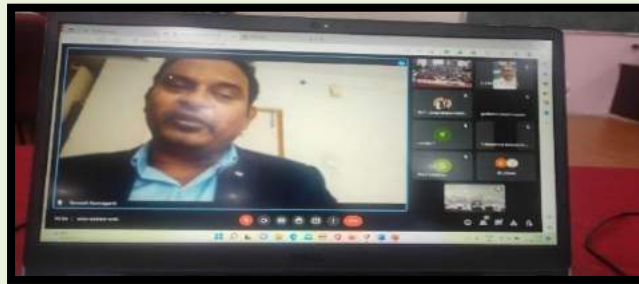

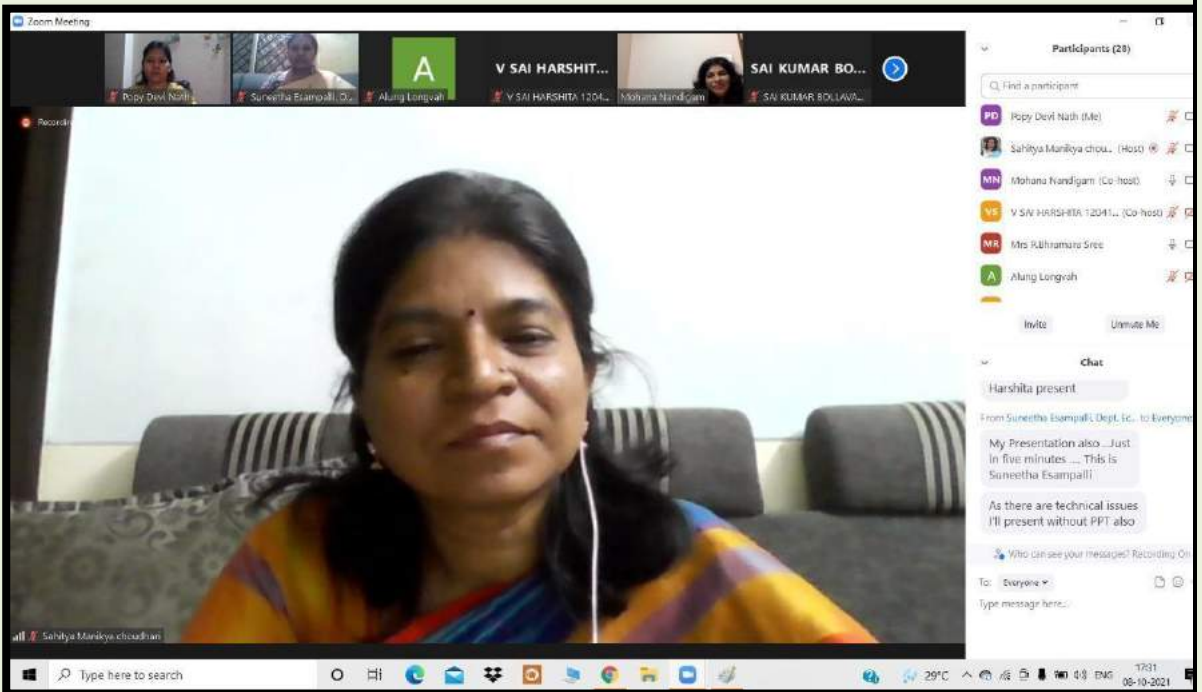

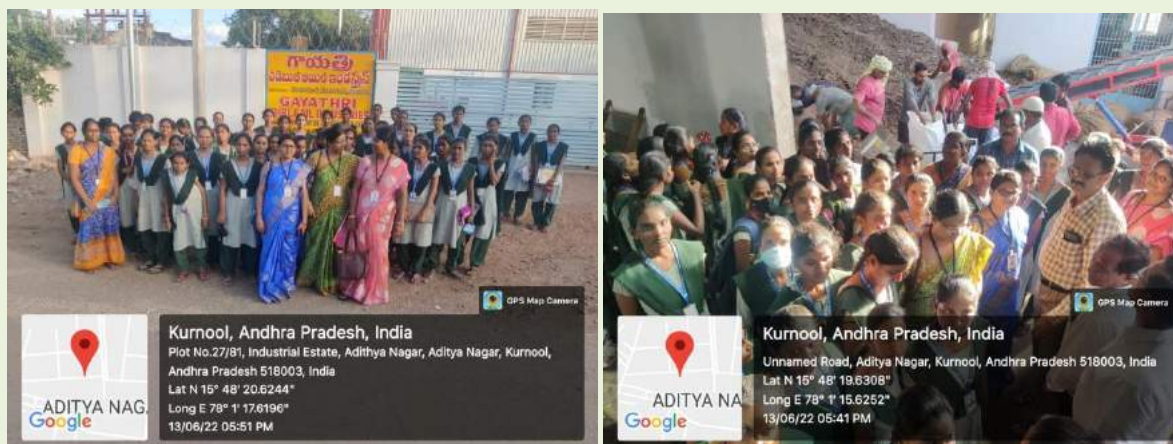

AND

WHEREAS KVR Govt. College for Women (A), Kurnool would be taking steps for the implementation of relevant programmes, mutually decided by both the parties, which would aim to enhance the employability of students by equipping them with Industry / Business relevant skills.

AND WHEREAS, MESc through its Education & Skill Development initiatives will work closely with its members and Industry Associations to help improve the quality of the employable skills of students of University/College. In this regard, there are various short, medium and long-term courses undertaken to meet this objective.

Now it is hereby mutually agreed amongst both parties to this MOU and binds themselves to the terms and conditions enumerated in succeeding paragraphs/Annexures:

**1. Roles and Responsibility**

The principal roles and responsibility of the parties will be as set out in Annexure A.

**2. Parties Shall**

- A. Not use other party's Intellectual Property unless such other party consents to such use.

- C. Keep each other informed of any matters relevant to the overall functioning.
- D. Share their expertise or any other information which would be of mutual benefit.

**3. Financial Terms and Conditions**

- A. College will pay the assessment fee, Rs. 1000/ Job role to MESc.

**4. Duration/ Term of the MOU:**

- A. The MOU shall begin from the date of its execution by the parties hereto.
- B. This MOU shall continue in full force and effect up to 5 years from the date of signing i.e. upto \_\_\_\_\_, 2027, that is the term required for completion of the three-year UG programme by three consecutive batches of students admitted from the Academic Year 2022-23 and Calendar Year 2022.
- C. Validity of this MOU shall be extended sufficiently early for further period/batches on mutual agreement by the parties to the MOU.
- D. This Memorandum of Understanding is a document of good faith and Implementation of the MOU would be monitored on a six-monthly basis.

**5. Termination**

- A. Either party may terminate this MOU by mutual understanding by giving 3 (three) months' notice in writing served on other.

- b) The parties to the MOU understand that, where a course, as aforesaid, is under continuance, the termination shall take effect only on completion of the subsisting course.
- c) Save as otherwise set out in this MOU, the termination of this MOU howsoever arising is without prejudice to the rights, duties and liabilities of either party accrued prior to termination.




#### 7. Confidentiality

  - The other party has consented in writing to the same being disclosed.
  - Is or has been independently developed by the other party without reference to or use of the confidential information.

#### 8. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes and differences whatsoever arising under or in connection with this MOU which could not be settled by parties through negotiations, after the period of thirty (30) working days from the service of the notice, shall be finally settled by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The parties will make reference for a sole arbitrator to be appointed by the parties in consultation with each other. The place of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.
