Preamble:

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to clarify the expectations, roles, and responsibilities of the collaboration between two academic Institutions on academics and research. This is not a legally binding agreement.

This MOU is entered into on the 23rd December 2021 by and between Department of Physics, Yogi Vemana University, Kadapa (hereinafter called YVU)

and

Department of Physics, KVR Govt. College for Women, R.S. Road, Narasimha Reddy Nagar, Kurnool–518004 (hereinafter called KVR), one of the Andhra Pradesh Government educational Institutions.

The previously mentioned institutions are hereinafter referred to individually as institute and collectively as institutes.

1. Objectives of the MOU

The objectives of the MOU are:

- a) To promote and enhance academic interest between YVU & KVR.
- b) To provide advice for implementation of quality of education at KVR.
- c) To encourage bright students of KVR to come for Post Graduate education at YVU.
- d) To promote research/continuing education activities between institutions.

2. Technical Areas of Collaboration

- a. A Continuing Quality Improvement Programme to improve quality of teaching staff at KVR through short-term/long-term certificate courses at YVU. Faculty of YVU could also be sent to KVR for necessary guidance.
- Provide academic interaction by delivering Special Lectures at KVR on topics of relevance to modern Industry.
- c. Provide necessary help in Organizing Workshops/conferences and Personality Development Programmes at YVU for enhancement of skills in respect of Faculty, Staff and Students of KVR.
- d. Provide necessary support for establishment of Video satellite link and assistance in development of E-class rooms, Lab, Curriculum, establishment of research Labs, Training & Placement and Library etc. at KVR.

3. Proposed Modes of Collaboration

YVU and KVR propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Cooperation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interest.
- b) Any other appropriate mode of interaction agreed upon between YVU and KVR.

4. Terms and Conditions

- a) The faculty members and students of KVR can use the library facility of YVU for short-time.
- b) Usage of YVU academic infrastructure can be allowed for limited period subject to its availability, approval of Head of the facility/department and Institute norms.
- c) Both institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- d) This MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the institutes at any time.
- e) Either Institute shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other institute.

5. Duration of MOU

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the institutes, shall expire in FIVE years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MOU shall be extended for another TWO years by mutual consent.

OUTCOMES: Field trips are crucial for every student to acquire increased knowledge, culture and hands-on experience. Students gained knowledge on the manufacture of Pet bottles and Leather boards and oil extraction process from seeds.






